However, perhaps plot 1 could be moved to the other side of the development to let in more light to the homes adjacent and also stop them being so over shadowed or overlooked. The highway infrastructure is disappointing at that end of the village, which carries a lot of HGV traffic and the members had concerns about pedestrian access and safety along this road.
